PLASTIC PACKAGING

- Disposable plastic cups and plates
- Bottles for water, soft drinks, oil, juice, milk, etc...
- Plastic cartons of tea, bottles of detergents, soaps, various products
- Tubes of creams, sauces, syrups, plastic straws, etc...
- Rigid plastic or polystyrene packaging for cakes and other foods, (*cold cuts, cheeses, fresh pasta, etc...*)
- Food trays (*eggs, ice cream, etc...*)
- Pots for yogurt, cheese spreads, desserts
- Nets for fruits and vegetables
- Containers for the packaging of various products (*cosmetics, wet wipes, powder products*)
- Plant pots (*maximum diameter 15/20 cm*)
- Packets for food in general (*pasta, rice, crisps, sweets, snacks, etc...*)
- General shopping bags
- Small plastic packaging (*multi-pack wrappers of bottles, toilet paper, etc...*)
- Polystyrene (*if large, reduce in size*)

ALUMINIUM AND TINS

- Tins and cans for foods (*tuna, meat, vegetables, animal food, etc...*)
- Aluminium cans
- Steel or aluminium lids or caps
- Aluminium food trays (*not too dirty*)
- Aluminium tubes (*mayonnaise, creams, etc...*)
- Nails, screws, wire and small metal materials from household maintenance

Do you have medium/large metal objects that you do not know where to dispose of?



For example: saucepans, bins, barrels, grids, shelves, etc...

Large objects in steel, aluminium or iron can be recovered and recycled by taking them to the municipal recycling centres.

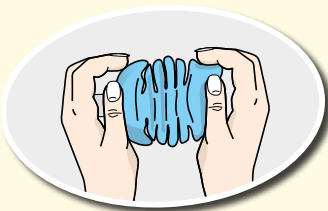

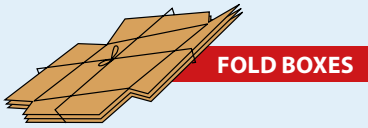


ATTENTION!

PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Magazines, journals, newspapers, books, notebooks, flyers, sheets of paper in general
- Tetra Pak (*the packaging from milk, fruit juice, etc...*)
- Cardboard boxes, and wrapping food stuffs (*pasta, rice, tuna, toothpaste, soaps, biscuits envelopes, etc...*)
- Boxes (*shoes, detergents, toys, etc...*)
- Egg boxes
- Pizza boxes (*not too dirty*)
- Paper bags for animal food
- Paper tablecloths

GLASS

- Carboys (glass only), flasks, bowls and trays

GENERAL HOUSEHOLD WASTE

USE THIS BIN TO BIN THROW AWAY ONLY WASTE THAT CAN NOT BE RECYCLED OR ITEMS THAT ARE MADE UP OF MORE THAN ONE MATERIAL WHICH CANNOT BE SEPARATED.

For example:

- Nappies, bed sheet protectors and sanitary products
- Plastic Cutlery
- Rubber and hard plastic toys
- Hard plastic coffee capsules
- CDs, DVDs, cassettes and videotapes
- Ceramic items, porcelain, ceramic and Pyrex
- Dust or contents of vacuum cleaner
- Coverings of carboys (*both plastic and straw*)

- Plates, x-rays, photographic films and slides
- Incandescent light bulbs
- Pens, markers and stationery in general
- Waxed paper, plastic and thermal paper (*receipts, fax, etc...*)
- Tights and socks
- Cigarette butts (*well stubbed-out*)
- Carpets, rags, fabrics and unused clothing
- Irrigation pipes
- Mirrors and crystals

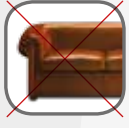

ORGANIC WASTE

- Off cuts of cold and drained food, raw or cooked
- Peelings, cores, kernels, vegetables, meat, fish bones, bones, rice, pasta, bread, biscuits, cheese, eggshells, spoiled foods (without packaging)
- Fruit and vegetable off cuts
- Coffee grounds, tea filters, chamomile and other teabags
- Absorbent kitchen paper, even if wet or greasy
- Leaves and flowers, plants, soil,
- Dried flowers and seeds
- Cotton buds (if biodegradable)

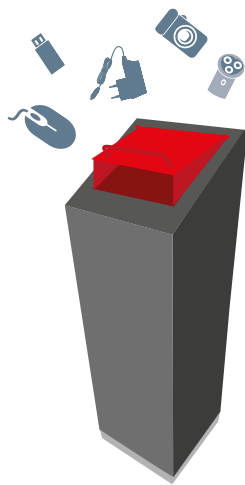

### WHY HAVE BINS FOR SMALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES?

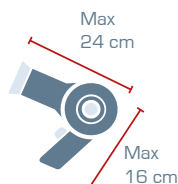
Small electronic devices, because they are small, are often "undervalued" and thrown away with the general household rubbish.

### WHAT CAN BE THROWN AWAY IN THESE BINS?

The bins are designed exclusively for small electrical and electronic items, such as battery chargers, hair dryers, smartphones, remote controls, cables, mp3 players etc.

#### NB

Electronic rubbish must not exceed **24x16 cm.**

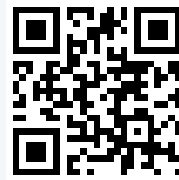
